Missouri County Profiles Adult Tobacco Use and Smoke-Free Policies

July 2010

The production of this booklet was supported by the Missouri Foundation for Health. Founded in 2000, MFH is an independent nonprofit organization and the largest non-governmental funder of community health activities in the state. Having provided \$300 million in funding to date, MFH's programs and grants support activities which improve the health of Missouri's citizens, particularly the uninsured and underserved populations.

Smoking remains the leading preventable risk of disease and death in Missouri. The state continues to lag behind the rest of the country in dedicated funding for tobacco control (ranked 49th) and has the lowest cigarette excise tax in the nation (\$0.17 per pack). Missouri has begun to make limited progress with the passage of several local smoke-free policies and a small amount of state funding for youth prevention. But, with over 8,500 Missouri youth becoming regular smokers each year and over 900,000 current adult smokers, much more work needs to be done.

Through *The Community Guide, Best Practices for Comprehensive Tobacco Control Programs*, and other evidence-based guidelines, we know what works. Policy change is the most effective way to prevent youth from starting to smoke and getting adults to quit. The purpose of this county profile book is to provide county-specific tobacco data to use in policy advocacy efforts.

Data included in this book are from the largest special survey ever conducted in Missouri. The 2007 Missouri County Level Study was the result of a public/private partnership between the Missouri Foundation for Health and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. The University of Missouri's Health and Behavioral Risk Research Center was contracted to conduct telephone interviews with approximately 50,000 Missouri adults between February 2007 and April 2008. This data set is envisioned to be a catalyst for change in Missouri, identifying and describing the health of communities to better inform health professionals and policy makers.

What Can You Do?

- Share these profiles with your colleagues, community members, and policy makers;
- Contact your closest tobacco control coalition to see how you can help;
- Advocate for smoke-free policies in your community; and
- Discuss with your local and state policy makers what you or your organization is doing to reduce the burden of tobacco use in Missouri.
