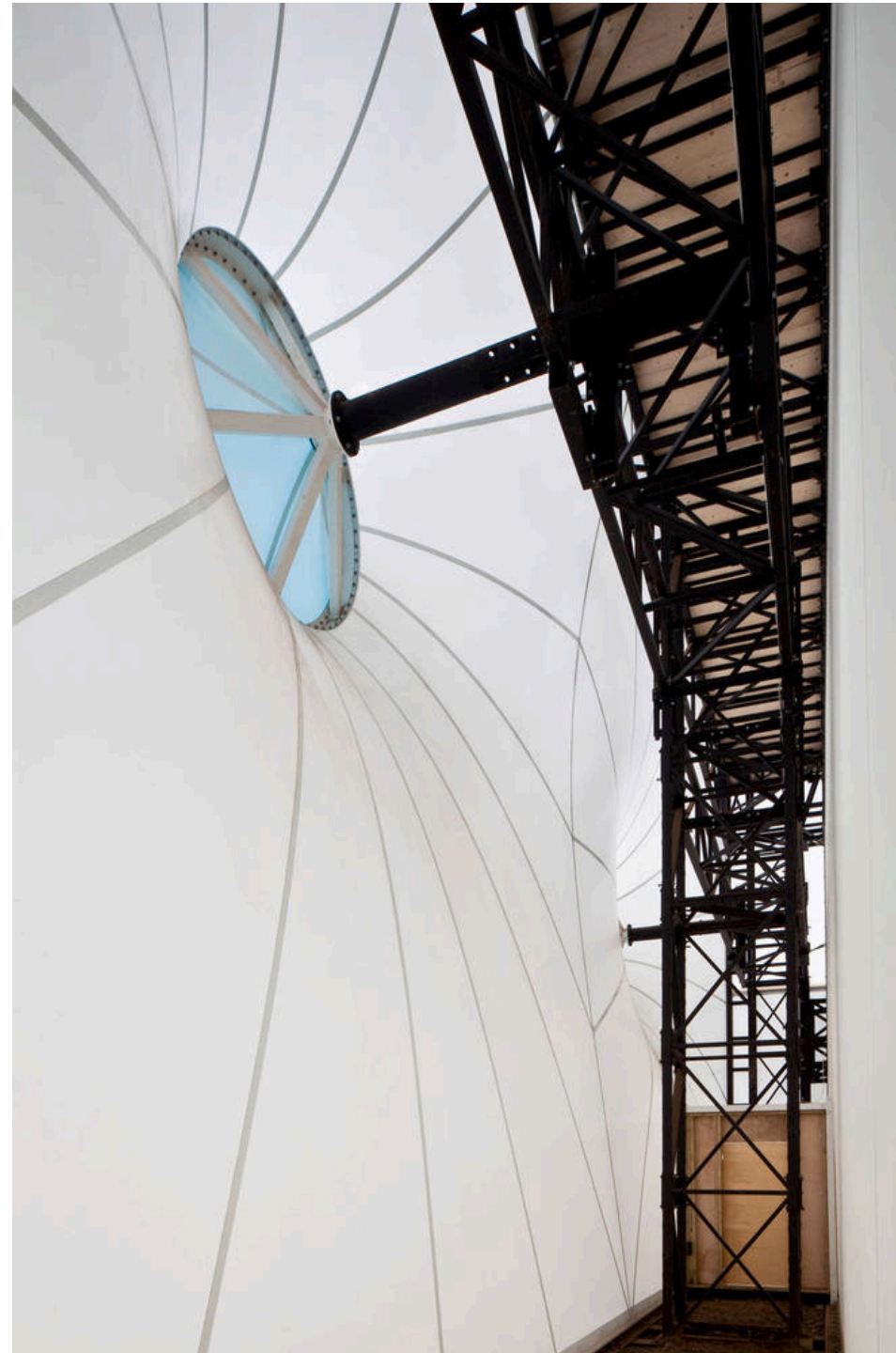
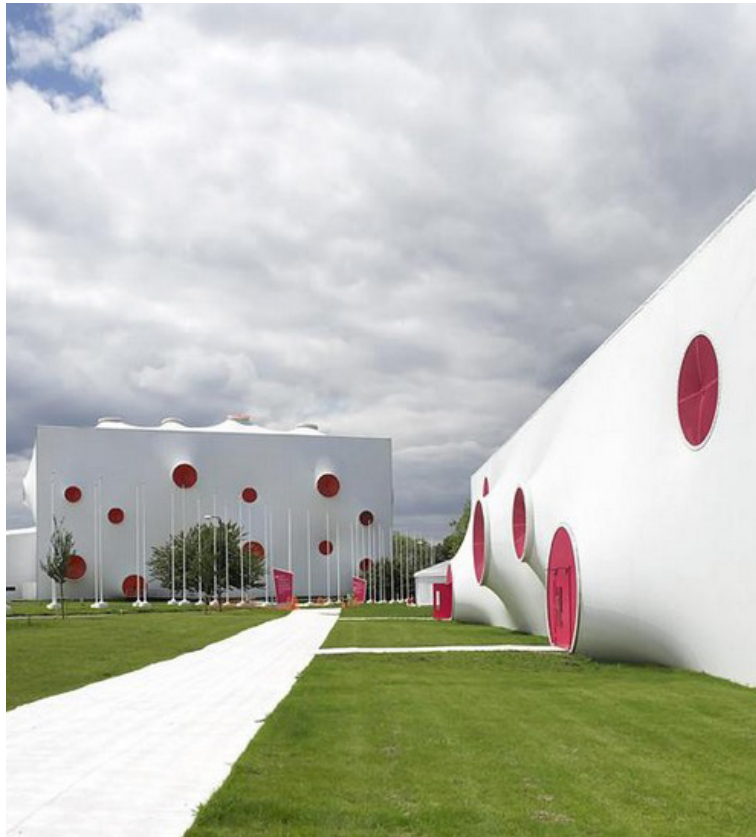


Olympic Shooting Venue
